Survey First Entry

It is submitted the Hull Surveyors be informed that this vessel has proceeded to their port to have her Machinery fitted on board, and to complete the survey on the hull the following requires to be done:-

- Tunnel to be tested complete
- Tunnel W. T. door to be examined and tested
- Downton pump to be tested
- Bridge deck, casings, etc. in way of machinery space to be riveted up, and deck tested in way of same
- Tonnages to be completed
- Pillaring in machinery space to complete

They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to forward a report on Form 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.

It is further submitted this report be returned to the Dundee Surveyors, who should be requested to fill in the spacing of the rivets and seams and butts of the shell plating.
