One copy of each of the plans is returned herewith, and I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.

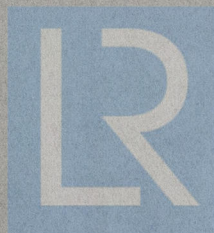
