I duly received your letter of the 13th instant, with enclosures, respecting the main and auxiliary boilers intended for the above vessel, and with regard thereto have to acquaint you as follows:-

Main Boilers.


The plan of cylindrical multitubular boilers will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates, butt straps and girders, viz:- 29-33 tons per sq. inch.

Auxiliary Boilers.

The plan of cylindrical boiler will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell
