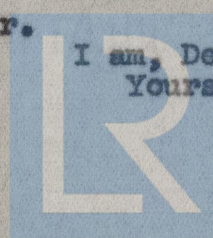

This is not in accordance with Section 3 of the Society's Rules for Electrical Equipment, but in view of the size and nature of the circuits so connected, no exception to such an arrangement will be taken in this instance.
