Dear Sirs,

E. I duly received your letter of the 25th instant, with plan, in triplicate, advised therein of crankshaft proposed by Messrs. Deutsche Werke Kiel A.G., Kiel, for three auxiliary diesel engines for Messrs. F. Schichau's Yard No. 1424.

The plan has been examined and I have to inform you that with 4 SCSA oil engines for driving auxiliary machinery, having 4 cylinders, diameter 280 mm., stroke 420 mm., span of bearings 310 mm., maximum pressure in cylinders 46 Kgs per sq. cm., M.I.P. 6.5 Kgs per sq. cm., B.H.P. 235, and revolutions per minute 360, the following size of crankshaft will be approved, viz:- 170 mm. diameter.

The plan showing details of crankshaft will also be approved, and two copies of this plan are being returned to you under separate cover.
