Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the m.s. "TAMESIS" we beg to acquaint you that we have conferred with the owner's superintendent and have today received the following letter-translated- from the owner:-

" We duly received your letter of the 11th instant with a copy of
 " Lloyd's letter regarding the classification of this vessel and
 " contents noted.
 " In reply we beg to state that we have today written to Lloyd's
 " Surveyor in Danzig, Mr. Stapelfeld, who completed the survey of this
 " vessel and requested him to send us for forwarding to London the
 " necessary classification reports for issuing of certificates, as
 " the British Surveyor had already left Danzig some days before the
 " vessel was completed. Mr. S. has carried out all the necessary
 " inspections on the machinery, whereafter he issued the usual interim
 " certificates on which the vessel is now sailing. Mr. S. Promised during
 " a conference with the undersigned on the trial trip to send First
 " entry Reports to Lloyd's in London as soon as possible, but these
 " have presumably not passed the censor as Lloyd's have not received
 " same. Should we in the meantime due to the circumstances not
 " receive the First Entry Report from Mr. S. we will call in Lloyd's
 " Surveyor to carry out the necessary inspections as requested by the
 " Head Office in their letter of the 28th ultimo.
 " A copy of our letter to Mr. Stapelfeld is attached."

The copy of Mr. Wilh. Wilhelmsen's letter to Mr. Stapelfeld is enclosed.

The owner requests to be informed regarding the amount of the fee for the survey.
