

Skeleton First Entry Reports have been prepared from the plans in the cases of the motorship "TAMESIS", built by Messrs. Schichau of Danzig for Mr. Wilhelm Wilhelmsen of Oslo, and also for the "ESSO BALBOA" built by Deutsche Werft for the Panama Transport Company.

In the case of the "TAMESIS" Mr. James C. Dykes, who is at present stationed at Wokingham, was able to complete the First Entry Report, and attached is a letter from him on the subject referring to the fees.

Detailed instructions are desired in both cases regarding the suggestion that the Owners might be approached regarding the payment of the fees.
