I have now completed the First Entry Report on the hull of the above vessel and fees would in the normal course be payable by Messrs. Schichau.

As, however, it is not possible to obtain payment from the Builders it is suggested that Mr. Wilhelm Wilhelmsen, the Owner of the vessel might be approached with a view to his making the necessary arrangements for settling the matter.

The fees for the hull are indicated in the First Entry Report, but the actual figures for the machinery are not available and it is thought that fees corresponding to fees charged on the case of the "TERRANNA", a similar vessel might be taken as a basis.
