

Twin screw M.V. "TAMESIS".

Builders : Messrs. F. Schichau G.m.b.H., Danzig. Yard No. 1424.

This vessel was built to class by Messrs. F. Schichau G.m.b.H. Danzig, and left Germany shortly before the outbreak of war. The first entry reports have not been received, but there appears no reason to doubt that the survey was duly completed.

In the circumstances, it is considered that a general examination, together with a confirmation of the leading particulars of the machinery, should be sufficient to entitle the vessel to be classed.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Oslo Surveyors be informed of the above circumstances and be requested to arrange with the Owners for the Society's Surveyors to make a general examination of the (vessel) and machinery at the first convenient opportunity.

The Surveyors should be asked to check and complete, as far as possible, the draft machinery first entry reports prepared from information available in this Office, and to make a general examination of the machinery and report the results to this Office.
