TALAMBA. — Allied H.Q. N. Africa, Aug. 6.—On the first night of the invasion of Sicily British hospital ship Talamba, lying fully lighted three miles off the Sicilian coast, was bombed and sunk.—Reuter.

London, Aug. 7.—The British India Steam Navigation Company state that according to the latest information casualties among members of the steamer Talamba are very few. There were no casualties among the European members of the crew.—Reuter.
