Hall, Ltd., attend at their Works at Dartford, Kent, on the 25th October, 1938, and subsequently, for the purpose of surveying during construction the refrigerating machinery intended for the S.S. "SULAGI" being built by Messrs. Hong Kong & Whampoa Dock Co., Ltd. to their Yard No. 804 and owned by Messrs. Burns, Philp & Co., Ltd.

The following parts have been subjected, in the presence of the undersigned, to the pressures stated and were found satisfactory.

The above air tests were applied whilst the parts were submerged in water at 90°F. The crankshaft forgings were tested at the Makers' Works, the marks on the shafts and the test results being as follows:-
