Dear Sirs,

We are at present considering fitting a watertight bulkhead in the hold of above vessel, and enclose herewith three prints showing details of how we propose constructing this bulkhead.

As you will observe, we have a mast fitted between frames 78 and 79, and it is our intention to weld the bulkhead direct to the mast, thus utilising the mast as a stiffener. The outboard side of the bulkhead will be welded direct to the shell between frames 78 and 79.

The material which we intend utilising for the bulkhead will be taken from stock, and the size of the stiffeners cannot be increased in depth from that shown on our plan.

We would esteem it a favour if you will be good enough to let us have approval as early as possible, as in all probability this bulkhead will require to be fitted under short notice.
