PROPOSED TIMBER CARRIER

Dear Sirs,

We herewith enclose duplicate prints of profile and decks and sections for a proposed timber carrier; the dimensions are 255'0" x 45'0" x 21'6", and to be classed 100 A1 with freeboard corresponding to a load draught of 13'0".

We shall be much obliged if you will be good enough to let us have the leading scantlings for this vessel, to enable us to prepare proper scantling plans, which we will submit to you later. This vessel will be solely employed in carrying long logs of timber, and it is our intention to have no web frames in the hold, pillars or other obstructions. As you will observe, this vessel has a hatch 110 feet long by 24 feet wide, and will be fitted with MacGregor Patent Steel Hatch Covers.


We would esteem it a favour if you could let us have this information as early as you possibly can, to enable us to proceed with our drawings.
