

Messrs. Fredriksstad Mek. Verkstad's
Yard Nos.287 & 289.

In a letter dated 11th March,1937, to the Oslo Surveyors approval was given to the use of boiler material which had been made and tested under the supervision of the Norske Veritas Surveyors.

A similar proposal was also agreed to in the case of the materials for the boilers of Messrs. Moss Vaerft's Yard No.75, at which time it was pointed out to the Oslo Surveyors that "if this material is not tested by the Society's Surveyors, it will, of course, not be possible to issue the usual Boiler Test Certificate (Cert.1), in view of the terms thereof, but a Report Form 10 could be issued, suitably worded to indicate the facts relating to the testing of the material". (30.7.37)

In the case of the boilers for Yard Nos.287 referred to above, the Surveyors have forwarded for signature Boiler Test Certificates made on Cert.1.

IT IS SUBMITTED that the attention of the Oslo Surveyors be drawn to the last paragraph of the Secretary's letter of the 30th July last, relating to the boilers for Messrs. Moss Vaerft's Yard No.75, and be informed that as the ruling referred to therein is applicable to the boilers now under notice, the Certificates in question should be
