The class is subject to LP crosshead
brasses & the combustion chamber being
examined on arrival in the U.K.; to the water
end of ballast-pump being renewed at
first opportunity and the condenser ferrules
renewed as necessary on return to the U.K.

The BS due 6.43 has been partly
held now and extensive repairs recommended.

The electrical equipment - has also been
examined & repairs effected & others recommended.

The General Examination became due 6.43
and screw shaft-survey due 1.43.

The vessel has now been requisitioned
for special Government-duty, and the Society's
class is no longer required.
