To complete a 3rd S.S. No.1 due 5,41 (vessel 23 years old) there remained the examination of the F.P. tank top plating and the testing of this tank.


The class is subject to indented shell plates E.4 and framing in way (s.s) and E.4 & 7 (p.s) being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The MARSEILLES Surveyor reports the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, F.P. tank top plating, excepting stringers, renewed and the S.S. as above, completed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as-classed with record of survey 6,42 and notation of S.S. No.1-41 subject as above.
