This vessel was built at Londonderry in 1918 under the survey of the British Corporation. The machinery & boilers were partly opened out & examined at Newport in 9. 19 & continued at Havre in 6. 20¹ ^{with a view to classification.}

To complete the survey for a record of LMC 6.20. the pumps, condenser, crank, thrust & tunnel shafts auxiliaries, pumping arrangement, starb^d & centre main & all boiler mountings require to be examined.

The screw shaft is fitted with a continuous line step jointed but not burned & will require to be examined at intervals of two years.


It is submitted action be deferred until the survey has been completed.
