The Owners - the Compagnie Havraise Peninsulaire de Navigation, of which Mr. Andre Grosos is the Director General, having desired that the vessel which is just completed be classed with this Society, the Builders wish to be informed of the expense that would be incurred if Lloyd's class were adopted, the vessel having been built under the survey of the British Corporation.

The Belfast Surveyors state that the tonnage for fees is 5380 and the nominal Horse Power 462.

The ordinary fees for survey while building and classification are as follows, :-

making a total fee of £210. 12. 0.

In some previous similar cases it has been considered that about 60% of the ordinary fee should be charged, this would amount to about £126.

It is submitted that a fee of £120 be charged for the survey and classification of the vessel ^{other machinery} in addition to any travelling expenses that may be incurred in carrying out the necessary survey.
