Sir,

Herewith enclosed, we beg to forward application forms for survey with a view to classification for the S.S. "VILLE du HAVRE" and "VILLE de ROUEN" Messrs The North of Ireland Shipbuilding Co's Nos. 72 and 73.

With reference to the "VILLE du HAVRE", we beg to state that it is understood this vessel will be at Newport, Mon., until about the end of next week and is now in drydock at that port.

The First Entry Report has been forwarded to the Surveyors together with the approved plans in order that the scantlings may be verified as far as practicable.

The S.S. "VILLE de ROUEN" is now completing at Londonderry and the various amendments shown on the approved plan of the sister vessel are now being carried out. The scantlings and arrangements are being verified and the First Entry Report together with free-board computation for both vessels will be forwarded in due course.

With reference to the amendments for the S.S. "VILLE du HAVRE" a plan is being prepared by the Builders showing clearly all the additions and it is understood that these alterations will
