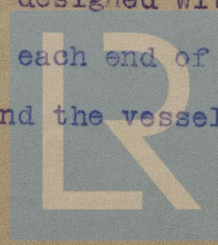
Sir,

Herewith enclosed, we beg to submit for consideration a letter which has been received from Messrs The North of Ireland Ship-building Co. having reference to a proposal to class their S.S. No. 72 "VILLE DU HAVRE" with this Society and enclosing plans showing the general scantlings of the vessel.

This vessel has just been completed and is now lying at Londonderry.

It will be observed from the plans enclosed that the scantlings and arrangements are very similar to those adopted in the case of the same Builders Nos. 70 and 71 S.S. "ASSIOUT" and "AMARNA", with the exception that the bridge sheer strake and side plating is lighter than in these vessels and the system of pillaring adopted is the same as that of the similar vessels "VILLE DU VERDUN" and "VILLE D'ARRAS" Nos. 68 and 69.

This vessel was originally designed with poop, bridge and forecastle, having short wells at each end of the vessel. These wells have now been filled in and the vessel has complete shelter
