I am in receipt of Mr. Turnbull's letter of the 16th instant and also Mr. Davies' letter of the same date regarding the case of the s.s. "VESTFOLD".

I am informed by the Sea Transport Department that they have just completed the final plan embodying the arrangements detailed in the memorandum which I sent you on the 10th instant. It is anticipated that this plan will be submitted to this Office to-morrow for final approval, and at the same time the Sea Transport Department here are sending an advance copy of this plan to their Newcastle Office for information. As soon as this final plan is approved, I shall send you a copy.

The Sea Transport Department state that there is no question of fitting additional watertight bulkheads in the tween decks of this ship.
