In connection with the employment of this vessel upon a particular service, I have been requested by the Department to consult with you in regard to the conversion, which involves the removal of all obstructions in the tween decks and the provision of larger hatches in the upper deck. The work will be undertaken in Palmer's Yard, Newcastle on Tyne.

To enable a preliminary investigation to be made a skeleton general arrangement and mid section have been prepared from the scanty particulars which we have recorded and it has not been possible, under the circumstances, to prepare more detailed drawings.

Perhaps, however, a joint consultation with you may result in some definite proposals being embodied in a guidance plan, which we could forward to Newcastle. Meetings can be arranged at your convenience.
