

 regarding the steamer "LORD STRATHCONA", Npt. Rpt. No.
 13. We have to state that the following repairs are necessary
 before vessel proceeds to sea with cargo.

On Port Side Amidships, some odd shell rivets to be cut
 and renewed, H.12 & L.12 to be cut off, faired and refitted,
 J & K.12 to be cut off and renewed.
 Longitudinal and transverse frames to be dealt with as found
 necessary.

Regarding other damage it is considered that the
 necessary repairs may be dealt with at first convenient opportunity.
