Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 3rd February last respecting the case of the Steamer "LORD STRATHCONA", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case again under their consideration, together with a report on the vessel received from the Society's Surveyors at Newport.

The Surveyors state that they have examined the vessel in drydock, and have made recommendations for the renewal of shell plating, framing, etc. It is understood that the vessel is to be put up to auction on the 11th August, and in the circumstances the Committee desire me to say that any intending purchaser should be informed that the vessel retains her class in the Society's Register Book, subject to the Special Survey No. 2, which became due in May 1923, being completed and all necessary repairs carried out before she proceeds to sea.
