The reservoirs have been built under Special Survey in accordance with the approved plans and the Society's Rules and requirements. The materials and workmanship are good.

On completion the reservoirs were tested by hydraulic pressure in the presence of the undersigned to 800 lbs. and found tight and sound in every respect.
