## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

EROS.—London, Jan. 4.—Berlin Radio reports to-night: Swedish motor vessel Eros, in the service of the International Red Cross, has met with an accident on her way from Piræus to Thessalonik owing to bad weather. According to reports so far received all the members of the crew could be rescued. The vessel and her cargo of grain, destined for the people of Thessalonik, must be presumed lost.—British United Press.

London, Jan. 4.—The German News Agency stated to-night that the Swedish motor vessel Eros has been wrecked in bad weather. The crew were rescued, but the ship and her cargo of grain were lost.—Reuter.

EROS.—New York, Jan. 5.—The American Swedish News Exchange to-day confirmed the German report that the Swedish motor vessel Eros, carrying grain from Canada to Greece, foundered in a gale while en route from Piræus to Thessaloniki and must be considered a total loss.—Reuter. (See issue of Jan. 6.)
