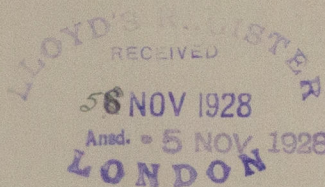

Dear Mr. Scott,

In possession of Your favoured lines of the 30th. ult., I am much obliged for the attention You have kindly given to my letter of the 26th. ult.-

Apparently, it has escaped Your attention, that we offer to guarantee whatever You may receive short of Your fees from the Clyde Shipbuilding Co., unless such guarantee does not suffice Your people.

The whole thing, in my opinion, is a matter of principle, and I think I cannot do better than to hand you a copy of our letter to our Solicitor at Glasgow.

If, in future, the question whether or not a vessel has deserved Your classification, is dependant upon the readiness of the builders to pay Your fees, the position of the shipowner would become rather unpleasant.
