Dear Mr. Scott,

I have called upon Mr. Dekkers to-day and had an interview with Mr. Dekkers Jr. on the subject of the payment of fees of the steamer "ZONNEWYK", as suggested in your letter of yesterday's date.

Mr. Dekkers stated that he regrets that in the circumstances he does not feel inclined to pay the fees, thus making a claim which he could send in respect thereof to the Liquidators.

When the vessel was taken over it was reported to him that all was in order, also the class of the vessel so that his last instalment was paid.

He on the other hand suggested that the Society might send in their claim as the building to class was applied for by the Builders, who will have to deliver the documents of class. Whilst I was present he wired to them referring to his letter that the certificates were urgently wanted and required immediate reply, for which was paid in advance.

Mr. Dekkers will keep me posted and in case anything may be heard by you please let me know so that I may see what further course to follow.
