FREEBOARD REPORT on the motor ship "Lopetka". Deutsche Werke No 198.

This submitted the Hamburg Surveyors be informed that their F.E. report has been received and it is noted that it is stated thereon that the vessel is a full scantling vessel and that freeboard is not a condition of class. This further noted that freeboards have been assigned by the Norwegian Authorities. Plans for this vessel were approved on 17.4.24 with a view to class 100A1 "with freeboard", and amended plans for a similar class were approved on 7.7.24. The Surveyors should therefore state if the particulars given on their report are correct, and if freeboard is a condition of class they should forward full particulars on form 116 together with a memo of the freeboards assigned by the Norwegian Authorities as such freeboards must receive the approval of the Committee.
