Dear Sir,

s.s. "WOLVERTON" I beg to inform you that Mr. Helyer, who I appointed as surveyor in connection with the repairs to this steamer, issued a seaworthy certificate to Mr. Peter Regier, who is acting here for the present owner, on the 19/2nd inst. The fees and expenses relating to the superintendence of the repairs and certificates amount to Rs. 1100.- which you stated in your favour of the 15th April, 1915, were to be paid by the owners. Mr. Regier has pointed out to me that the ship had to be delivered to him with Lloyd's Classification Certificate, and that therefore the former owners, Messrs. The Denaby & Cadeby Main Collieries Ltd., should pay all fees and expenses in connection with the surveying of the repairs carried out here. The Captain of the s.s. "Wolverton" before leaving Odessa informed me that the present owner was responsible for all expenses after the 3/16th September.

In view of the foregoing, I shall be glad if you will request Messrs. The Denaby & Cadeby Main Collieries Ltd. to remit me the amount mentioned above, so that I may be in funds when Mr. Helyer sends in his account.
