Dear Sir,

In confirmation of my cablegram of yesterday respecting the steamer "WOLVERTON", I have to acquaint you that the Owners state that the vessel has arrived at Odessa after having been damaged by a mine. The vessel is expected to dry dock about the 25th instant and they wish the repairs to be carried out under supervision. As, however, the Society has no surveyor stationed now at Odessa, the Committee will be much obliged if you will kindly get into touch with the British Consul, who is acquainted with the facts of the case and has been in communication with the Owners, and appoint a competent and independent surveyor to survey the repairs of the vessel.

I enclose forms for reporting the result of the surveyor's inspection and shall be obliged if you will kindly return the documents in question to me in due course.

I have to add that all fees and expenses in connexion with this matter must be paid by the Owners or their Representatives and should accordingly be charged by
