Nature of Survey

FIRST ENTRY.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Christiania Surveyors should be requested to state:-

1. Whether they are correct in reporting the size of the frames as 8" x 3" x .47".
 2. Whether they are correct in reporting the size of the face angles on side stringers as 6" x 3½" x .36". ✓
 3. Whether built pillars are fitted at the ends of hatchways as shown on the approved plan.
 4. Whether the inner surface of the bottom plating is covered with cement, & if not, This has been omitted at Owners Request.
- They should also be requested to forward the plan showing the bulkhead stiffening.
