**NAVAL TRAWLER BOMBED AND SUNK**  
 An Admiralty communique issued yesterday announced the loss of H.M. trawler *Rifnes*, temporary skipper C. G. Coombe, R.N.R., as the result of a bombing attack by enemy aircraft. There were three casualties. The *Rifnes*, before being taken over by the Admiralty, was owned by Oddsion & Co., Ltd., Hull. She was built in 1932 and had a tonnage of 431 gross.
