## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

IOANNA. A Greek steamer, built in 1907, was sunk by a submarine on 1st June 1940, north of Finisterre. The crew of 12 were rescued, and the cargo of 1,000 tons of coal was saved. The ship was carrying 1,000 tons of coal for the Greek Government.
