Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that consequent upon damage in an air raid in January last the steamer "SUZY" proceeded to Oran, where she was examined by a Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agents and reported to be unseaworthy.

She was subsequently anchored outside the breakwater at Arzew, but as no repairs were put in hand the Committee in July last expunged her class and inserted in the Register Book a casualty record of "Damaged by Aircraft 1,39".

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter, dated 16th instant received from Captain N.B.Mataxas, the Owner's Agent here, together with a copy of my reply, from which you will observe that upon application from the Owner, or his representatives, you will be in order in making an examination of the hull and machinery with a view to the issue of an Interim Certificate for the vessel to proceed to Piraeus for permanent repairs. As this vessel no longer holds the Society's class, any certificate issued by you should be on the certificates specially designed for such cases, namely Form C and/or Cl.
