Having been appointed Owner's representative in London, I find that the above named steamer is lying in Algiers, and that she is struck off from the Register - owing to damage that she sustained after being bomb-barded a few months ago, whilst in Spain.

The Owner, now intends to take the ship to Greece for permanent repairs and he is informed that the damage is all above water and that it is not extensive; he hopes therefore, that the vessel can proceed to Piraeus with very small, if any temporary repairs and after her arrival in Piraeus, he will carry out the instructions of your Surveyor to put the ship in order, in accordance with the rules of your Society.

I would be obliged to you, if you let me know what would be your Society's requirements for temporary repairs to enable the ship to proceed to Piraeus, so that the necessary arrangements might be done without any undue delay.
