As further advice has been received to the effect that no repairs have yet been carried out, the Committee regret that they do not see how they can allow the class to remain in the Register Book any longer, and in all the circumstances, they have given instructions for the record "Damaged by aircraft 1,39" to be made against the vessel's name in the Register Book and to expunge her class in accordance with the terms of my letter above referred to.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary repairs, the case will receive the favourable
