I beg to inform you that a new vessel, the S. S. "SHELLIE", built here by the Dublin Dockyard Co., and launched yesterday, has left to-day, in tow, for Glasgow, to be fitted with Engines and Boiler by Messrs. Ross & Duncan.

Enclosed please find Rpt. 4, on the parts of the Machinery fitted whilst the vessel was on the stocks.

In regard to the hull, this is practically finished, but on account of some necessarily incomplete casings etc., the decks require to be tested when all deck work, casings, etc., have been completed to your satisfaction.
