

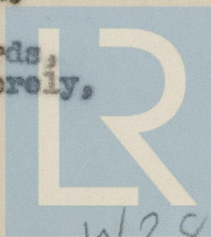

I take this opportunity to refer also to your official letter of the 19th instant regarding the Screwshaft Survey on the "THOMAS BARTLETT".

We have not yet received any letter from Mr. Limbrick but, having regard to the present state of emergency we are anxious to avoid worrying Owners any more than is necessary. In point of fact the Committee usually allow at least six months in which to carry out a screwshaft survey which in this case would take her up to the end of the year, so that I suggest you arrange with Mr. Limbrick for the shaft to be drawn without fail at her next slipping, which will doubtless be within this period.
