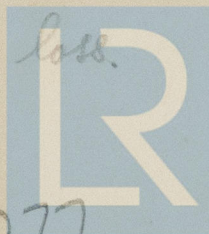
The class is subject to mainmast, derricks and rigging being renewed on arrival at a home port.
