With reference to your First Entry Report No.18164 on the S.S."GRETASTON", I have to inform you that it would appear from pencil lines on the sketch of midship section that the tumble home at the bridge deck is much less than originally intended, and as it is necessary to know exactly the amount of the tumble home before preparing the classification certificates, I shall be glad if you will be good enough to inform me by wire whether the shape of the vessel as indicated on the sketch of midship section has been departed from, and if so what the amount of the tumble home is at the bridge deck.
