Reverting to your letter of the 25th ultimo, I have the pleasure to acquaint you that it appears that the compressive stresses at the bridge deck in the vessel (Your No. 758), the scantlings of which were approved by the British Corporation, would be, under the loading assumed as for condition "C", 8.6 tons per square inch.

The Chairman would be glad if you would kindly let him know why you thought that the British Corporation ship would fulfil condition "C" without trouble arising.
