I duly received yours of 2nd, and as requested therein I have pleasure in sending you herewith Body Plan giving Transverse Sections of the vessel, and also Displacement Scale, which I trust will suit your purpose. The light weight of the ship is 2915 tons with steam up, but without stores or fresh water.

It may also be of interest to know that the draft as observed by us at the Tail-of-the-Bank after trial and before the vessel's departure on her first voyage was 12'6" forward and 17'6" aft. Displacement at this draft we make 6900 tons, the longitudinal centre of gravity being 7'1½" abaft midships.
