




In order to pursue the investigation into this case it is necessary, in addition to the information contained in Mr. Cairns' report, to have a transverse section of the vessel at displacement stations, and also the displacement scale, together with the light weight of the ship, and it is suggested that Col. Lithgow might be asked to be so good as to kindly arrange for this information to be furnished if possible.

In view of the remarks in regard to the bulkhead of the deep tank, it is considered that the Hull Surveyors, in forwarding information as to loading on the homeward voyage, should report whether any cargo was damaged by sea water.
