Messrs. Wm. Denny & Bros. Ltd. - Yard No. 1333
Plan of Motor Seating.

I beg to acquaint you that a plan of motor seating for the above vessel, which is to be built with a view to class A- "With Freeboard" "For Irish Channel Service", has been submitted by the Builders.

The plan has been examined in this Office and certain suggested amendments have been indicated thereon in pencil. It has been compared with the plan of engine seating for the same builders' Yard No. 1330, a vessel with engines of approximately the same horse power and being built with a view to class A- "With Freeboard" "For Service between London, Cherbourg and Hook of Holland from May to September". The plan for this latter vessel was forwarded to you with my letter of the 20th January last.

As cases of engine seatings for vessels of similar class and service to that now being dealt with may have been approved in your Office, it is thought desirable to forward the plan and I shall be glad if you will kindly state/

state whether the scantlings as shown and amended thereon are considered satisfactory or suggest any modifications which you might consider desirable.

It may be observed that the Builders state the material is ordered to the scantlings and arrangements as proposed on the plan.

The plans of Midship Section and Profile & Decks and Bulkheads for this vessel, together with the plans of Midship Section, Profile & Decks and Engine Seating for the same Builders' No.1330 are enclosed for reference and I shall be glad to receive an early reply in this case.
