I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo, with enclosures, in further reference to the electrical installation proposed to be fitted on Messrs. Wm. Denny Bros.' Yard No.1333.

The plans forwarded with your letter of the 17th ultimo have now received consideration, and these plans will be approved, provided the installation be as shown and amended thereon and to the satisfaction of the Surveyors, and the remaining requirements of the Rules for Electrical Equipment be complied with.

I should point out, however, that it is noted that the diagram of connections of the main switchboard shows several instances of two outgoing circuits connected to a common double pole switch. Such an arrangement does not comply with Section 3, Clause 3 (g), of the Rules for Electrical Equipment, but, in view of the size and nature of the circuits so connected no exception will be taken to such an arrangement in this instance.
