I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant respecting a 60 gallon fuel service tank for a 3VSOZ (22½ BHP) generating and compressor set proposed by Messrs. Ruston & Hornsby, Ltd., and note that, due to an oversight, the plan of this tank was not submitted for consideration prior to the commencement of the construction of the tank.

The plan now forwarded has been examined, and I have to acquaint you that the thickness of the tank plating is somewhat less than required by the Society's usual practice. Since the tank is already constructed, however, it will be accepted in this instance provided that, when under hydraulic test, it is sound and tight and free from distortion. Two copies of the plan are returned herewith.

I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain and let me know the name of the Shipbuilders and the Yard Number of the vessel for which this tank is intended.
