A. With reference to your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the flexible metallic tubes for Messrs. Wm. Denny & Bros. Engine No.1083, I have to inform you that one of the Society's Surveyors attended the works of The United Flexible Metallic Tubing Co. on the 4th instant to carry out the tests of three lengths of lubricating oil filling tubes. It is understood that these are to replace those previously tested on the 21st March last (as per Special Certificate No.D.1577, a copy of which is enclosed), a different type of gland having been supplied at the request of the Board of Trade Surveyor.

In the circumstances it is not considered necessary to issue a fresh certificate.
