Dear Sirs,

E. I duly received your letter of the 19th instant respecting the Flexible Tubing supplied by you to Messrs. Wm. Denny & Bros' Orders Nos. MB.7793/4/5 and intended for their Yard No.1330, and note that through inadvertence this tubing has been despatched without being inspected by one of the Surveyors to this Society, but that it has been examined and tested by the Board of Trade Surveyor.

In this connexion, I have to state that no exception will be taken to the low pressure pipes being fitted on board, provided they are examined under working conditions and found satisfactory by the Society's Surveyors, but that arrangements will require to be made at the Shipyard for the compressed air pipes to be tested to twice their working pressure.

I am to add that, in all future cases, it will be necessary for the appropriate tests required by the Society's Rules to be carried out in the presence of the Society's Surveyors.
