In July last the Committee agreed to a proposal to carry out the Third Special Survey No. 2 at the end of the year. In January last the Owners informed the Hull Surveyors that the Special Survey would be dealt with immediately the vessel could be spared from service. In the circumstances action was deferred for a short time.

The Owners now write that they hope to deal with outstanding surveys in the near future, but point out that ship repairing firms are exceptionally busy at the present time, and it is difficult to get work done.

Submitted the Owners be requested to arrange for the vessel to be generally examined (in accordance with Circular No 1764) with a view to a postponement of 6 months minimum being agreed to.
